

Directions to our London Office

From St Pauls Station

Leave St Paul's underground station taking the exit to the north side of Cheapside and turn left along Cheapside in the direction of Bank. After approximately 500 yards take the third turning left off Cheapside into Wood Street. Proceed down Wood Street crossing Gresham Street and just before the main road (London Wall) on the left hand side are steps leading up to the entrance of 88 Wood Street, a stunning glass building (designed by Richard Rogers – architect of the Pompidou Centre in Paris). You will need to sign in at the ground floor security desk before enjoying a breathtaking view over the City as you take the glass elevator to the 13th floor reception.

From Moorgate Station

Exit Moorgate underground station onto Moorgate and turn right down to London Wall. Cross the road and turn right along London Wall. After approximately 350 yards turn left into Wood Street and the steps to 88 Wood Street are immediately on your right. Alternatively if you prefer to avoid the heavy traffic on London Wall you can exit the underground station into Moor Place and turn right up the steps onto St Alphage High Walk. After 400 yards there is an enclosed walkway across London Wall and the steps bring you down onto the street right beside 88 Wood Street.
